10. National Higher Education System

The Luxembourg post-secondary university level sector consists of:

- A public university, maintained by the state
- · Foreign universities operated by private organizations, some of them with state accreditation

The Luxembourg post-secondary non-university level sector consists of 2-year vocational training programmes as Higher Technician Certification in:

- · Health (midwifes, nurse, health technicians)
- · Construction and building
- Information technology
- · Trading (accounting, marketing, tax)
- · Arts (pre-press design, comics, cinema, script)



The following text addresses exclusively the University of Luxembourg, founded by the law of 12 August 2003, which is the main actor of higher education in Luxembourg.

Academic year, credit system and grading

The academic year normally runs from mid-September to mid-July, and lasts for a maximum of 10 months. Courses are measured in teaching units, according to the European Credit Transfer system standard (ECTS). The full-time workload for one academic year is 60 ECTS.

According to the modalities for examinations outlined in the curricula, achievements may be evaluated upon the basis of oral, written examinations or project-related work or a combination of these. Grades for undergraduate and postgraduate examinations are awarded according to a scale from 20 (highest) to 0 (lowest), with 10 as the minimum pass grade.

Admission, degrees and qualifications

Admission to a Bachelor programme (180 ECTS) is granted to holders of a Luxembourgish secondary school leaving certificate or a diploma or certificate that is recognised as equivalent by the Luxembourg Ministry of Education. However, for most Bachelor programmes, there is an additional selection procedure, either via an entrance examination or on the basis of an application file submitted by the candidate.

Holders of a Bachelor degree (180 ECTS) or equivalent have access to the Master level. There is a specific selection procedure for all Master programmes (2-year duration). Admission decisions are taken by an admission committee, on the basis of an application file and in some cases an entrance examination and/or a personal interview. The selection criteria differ from one Master programme to another and are published at http://www.uni.lu.

The Doctoral degree is awarded after three years of study, following the completion of a Master's degree (120 ECTS). The faculties of the University of Luxembourg offer doctoral programmes.
